Kokomo Joe's Announces Multi-Level Indoor Go-Kart Experience Coming to St. Charles County in 2026

Family-owned entertainment destination brings rare multi-level karting attraction to the St. Louis region

ST. PETERS, MO. — Kokomo Joe's Family Fun Center has announced plans for a new multi-level indoor go-kart attraction scheduled to open in October 2026, marking one of the most ambitious entertainment expansions in the company's history. The multi-million-dollar project represents one of the largest investments in the company's 13-year history and will bring a rare racing attraction to St. Charles County.

Designed in partnership with global track designer 360 Karting, the new experience will feature a multi-level racing track engineered to appeal not only to families, but young adults, corporate groups, and competitive racers looking for a more elevated entertainment experience.

The upcoming track will span approximately 1,125 feet in total length with multiple elevation changes and immersive track elements designed to create a high-energy racing environment rarely seen in the Midwest. With fewer than 40 comparable multi-level indoor karting tracks currently operating in the United States, the attraction will offer a racing experience unlike anything else in the St. Louis region.

For Kokomo Joe's owners Angel and Joseph Johnson, the project is also deeply personal. The family-owned and operated business has served the St. Peters community for more than 13 years, and the Johnson family has long been passionate about the sport of karting. Their three sons each raced karts growing up and today operate their own karting teams, giving the family firsthand experience with what racers value most on and off the track.

The Johnson family's passion for the sport, combined with a significant investment in world-class track design and technology, reflects their commitment to delivering an authentic karting experience while remaining accessible to first-time racers, families, and seasoned competitors alike.

"Karting has been a part of our family's life for years," said Angel and Joseph Johnson, owners of Kokomo Joe's Family Fun Center. "Our three boys grew up racing. We've spent countless weekends at tracks across the country and understand what makes a great racing experience. When we decided to bring karting to Kokomo Joe's, we wanted to create something truly

special—an attraction that combines the excitement racers love with an experience that families, friends, and first-time drivers can enjoy together. We believe this will be one of the most unique attractions in our region and a destination guests will want to return to again and again."

The attraction is part of a broader vision to continue modernizing and expanding Kokomo Joe's offerings as the entertainment industry increasingly shifts toward experience-driven attractions designed for wider age demographics. The addition reflects the company's commitment to creating memorable experiences for guests of all ages while continuing to evolve beyond traditional family entertainment offerings.

Renderings released by the company showcase a dramatic multi-level track featuring elevated racing sections, sweeping turns, modern lighting effects, and an immersive visual environment inspired by contemporary indoor karting venues found in larger metropolitan markets.

The announcement comes on the heels of another milestone for the business. In May 2025, Kokomo Joe's was honored with the St. Peters Small Business Award, recognizing the company's impact on the local community and commitment to serving families throughout the region.
